Heart of TN USBC Youth Tournament

Tournament Rules

1. Entries will be open to 2025 - 2026 Heart of TN USBC youth bowlers.
2. The Heart of TN USBC Youth tournament will be held at Smyrna Bowling Center on November 29, 2025 for youth 18 and younger. Bowlers can compete by age and gender in one of the following divisions: U8 (8/1/17 or later), U10 (8/1/15 – 7/31/17), U12 (8/1/13 – 7/31/15), U14 (8/1/11 – 7/31/13), U16 (8/1/09 – 7/31/11) and U18(8/1/07 – 7/31/09)
3. Each entrant shall use their BOWL.COM Heart of TN USBC 2024-2025 composite average based on 9 games.
This tournament is for Heart of TN Youth Bowlers Only.
4. Every Fee will be \$22 per bowler, per event (Doubles and Singles) Breakdown is as follows: Lineage \$11.25; Prize Fund \$9.25; Tournament Manager \$1.50. No entry will be accepted without bowling entry fees.
5. **The tournament will consist of two events: Doubles and Singles.** Entrants may bowl in one or both events. Doubles can only win once with the same partner. In case of a tie for doubles, prize money is divided equally.
6. The tournament will be contested on a Smyrna Bowling Center standard house shot. Lanes will be reoiled between shifts. Two three-game qualifying blocks on the same pair of lanes. Singles event will be bowled first and then Doubles on the same pair of lanes.
7. Team captains are responsible for correct averages. Incorrect averages are cause for disqualification without a refund of entry fee. USBC rule 319a-3 will apply. The team captain will list the bowlers on the entry form in the order which they will bowl. Not change in lineup will be permitted.
8. USBC Rules shall govern the tournament. USBC rule 319a.2 (10 pin increase) and 319e (15 pin increase) and 319d (Reporting of Prize Winnings) will be waived.
9. The handicap will be **90% of 220**. Handicap is subject to re-rating at the discretion of the Tournament Manager, Jay Hendrickson.
10. All prize fees will be returned 100% to the participants based on the number of entries to USBC SMART accounts.
11. The tournament manger has the right to reschedule bowling times to fill schedules. In case of machine breakdown with undue delay, the game may be continued on any pair of lanes with each bowler receiving two practice balls on each pair of lanes.
12. Bowlers must check in with the tournament official 30 minutes prior to bowling. Tardy bowlers may bowl beginning with the frame being bowled. NO make-up frames will be allowed. In case of an emergency, failing to show at the scheduled time, may be rescheduled with the approval of the tournament committee.
13. Lanes will be assigned by computer program or tournament manager.
14. Computer printouts will be the official score. Bowlers will be responsible for watching their score. Only a Heart of TN USBC Officer or Director will be allowed to adjust scores.
15. The decision of the tournament committee shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC rule 329. The Tournament Manager will accept corrections of scoring errors up to 24 hours after the end of the last squad.
16. Final prize listing and prize funds will occur withing 30 day from the tournament.

Dress Code

Tournament committee reserves the right to determine if the uniform worn by the participant is acceptable. Bowlers are required to wear suitable attire when participating in Youth Tournament. No indecent attire, short skirts, short shorts, halter tops, T-shirts or bowling equipment with tobacco or alcohol advertising. Pants must be worn at waist level. If the uniform is determined to be unacceptable, the participant is required to change the uniform immediately. Male participants are required to wear full-length pants/slacks during all levels of competition. Female participants are required to wear slacks, capris, skorts or walking shorts, no gym shorts. All skorts or walking shorts must be below the competitor's fingertips when they are standing with their arms hanging loosely at their side. No writing on or defacing of the bowling shirt will be permitted at any time. No head covering or sunglasses can be worn while practicing or competing (Hats, Caps, or Bandannas, etc.).

Code of Conduct

Competitors are not allowed to use tobacco or vape products during competition or related events while in their bowling shirt. Failure to comply with this rule will result in disqualification from the tournament. Consumption of alcoholic beverages and/or use of illegal drugs by any participant at any time will result in immediate disqualification from the tournament. Advertisements on apparel or bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, or inappropriate language/gestures during tournament completion will not be allowed and may result in disqualification from the tournament.
